Group 4 and above

Do any of your kids dream of performing, singing and acting in a theatre? musical dance battle could just be perfect for them. An after school musical and theatre project for kids from 6-12 years. During a period of around 19 lessons (including the final repetition) the kids, together with a theatre/ musical coach create a mini musical like Annie, The Whiz, Matilda etc.. Singing, dancing and performing is a key part of the overall lesson. They will finish off the lessons in April with a performance in the theatre where the 'battle' between the different schools will take place. A panel will judge the musicals of each group.
