## Start of new school year for primary and secondary education

From the start of the new school year, the following rules apply for primary and secondary education:

### Primary Education

- All students can fully attend school.
- Pupils do not have to keep a distance of 1.5 meters to fellow pupils or teaching staff.
- Education staff maintains a distance of 1.5 meters from each other each other and to parents (and parents to each other).
- Teachers who have not been (fully) vaccinated test themselves twice a week preventively with a self-test.

### Secondary Education

- All students can fully go to school.
- Pupils keep 1.5 meters distance from teaching staff.
- Pupils do not have to keep a distance of 1.5 meters
- Pupils do not have to keep a 1.5 m distance from fellow pupils.
- School personnel keep a distance of 1,5 m to each other.
- Pupils and staff wear a mouth mask when moving around the school. For example in the hallway and the auditorium. Seen in the classroom, the mouth mask off.
- Teachers and students who have not been fully vaccinated test themselves preventively twice a week with a self-test. Risk-based testing is dropped.
- Teachers and students who are at least two weeks been fully vaccinated for at least two weeks will no longer have to go into quarantine if they have had contact with an infected person.
